Respect privacy - seek permission before entering another student's room or posting social media featuring another student.



Refrain from mobilephone use during classes
or any activities.

Prioritise well-being -



Boundaries - Boys and girls have separate living spaces that must be respected.



Shared responsibility - In the rare event of "Code of Conduct" violations leading to a student being sent home, associated costs will be covered promptly by the parent/guardian or booking representative.



Only drugs prescribed by a doctor for a medical condition are allowed. Hand in on arrival for safekeeping.



Be positive - Refrain from fighting or using offensive language.



Seek permission - Students need permission to leave the camp unaccompanied.
